Signing in can also be done from a smartphone



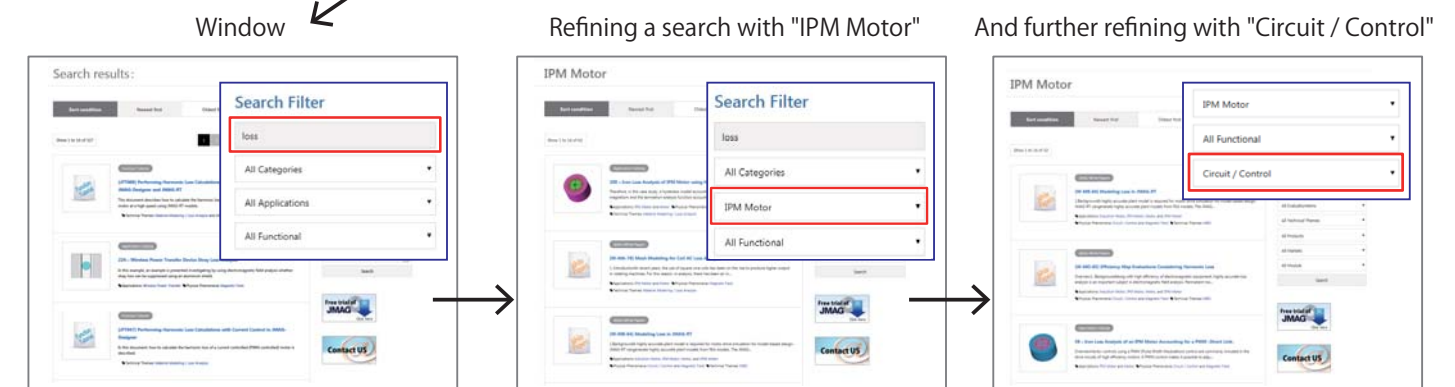
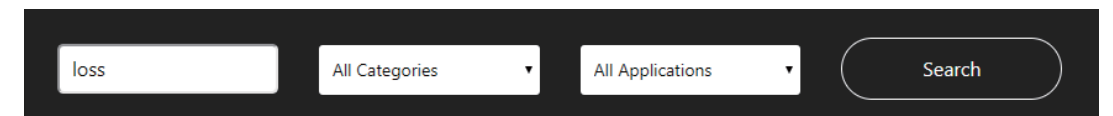
Searching for material
